<b>Format</b>	<p>Complete at your own pace.</p> <p>HeartCode BLS uses a variety of eLearning assets such as dramatizations, eSimulations, animations, self-directed learning, and interactive activities to teach students BLS knowledge and skills.</p> <p>HeartCode BLS is the AHA's BLS blended learning, in which a student completes part of the course in a self-directed manner, followed by a hands-on skills session.</p>	<p>Must complete during specific classroom time-period. Instructor-led, hands-on class format reinforces skills proficiency.</p> <p>The BLS Instructor-led course teaches both single-rescuer and team basic life support skills for application in both prehospital and in-facility environments, with a focus on High-Quality CPR and team dynamics.</p>
<b>Course Completion</b>	<p>Complete the <u>online portion</u> at your own pace, then schedule the hands-on skills session with Respond Right EMS Academy.</p>	<p>Attend a classroom session at Respond Right EMS Academy</p>
<b>Time</b>	<p>The online portion of HeartCode BLS can be completed in the comfort of your home in approximately 1 to 2 hours.</p> <p>Then complete the hands-on skills session. Usually takes about 1.5 hours, depending on the experience of the student.</p>	<p>BLS Provider Course takes approximately 4.5 hours to complete, including skills practice and skills testing</p>
